1. Have there been times when you treated the Bible casually instead of holy? What happened, and how did you deepen your reverence for God’s Word?

2. Read **2 Timothy 3:16-17**. What does it mean for Scripture to be inspired by God and trustworthy in every way?

3. According to **2 Peter 1:21**, how were the Old Testament prophets guided in writing Scripture, and why is this significant?

4. In what way does **2 Peter 1:20-21** affirm the inspiration and purpose of Scripture, as seen in **2 Timothy 3:16-17**?

5. **2 Timothy 3:16-17** reminds us that God’s Word is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness. How has God’s Word recently impacted you in one of these ways?

6. Read **2 Timothy 3:1-5, 13**. Considering the challenges Timothy faced as a young leader, how might the authority and sufficiency of Scripture have been an encouragement to him?

7. What steps can you take this week to cultivate a greater respect for the Bible in your daily habits?

PERSONAL REFLECTION & DEEPER STUDY FOR THIS WEEK

- Memorize **2 Timothy 3:16-17**.
- Read **Isaiah 6:3 along with Psalm 99:1-3 and Revelation 4:8**.
 - What do these verses teach about God’s holiness?
 - What is the significance of the repetition “Holy, holy, holy”?
 - How do these passages describe the reaction of heavenly beings to God’s holiness?
- Read **2 Peter 2:20-21 along with Matthew 12:43-45 and Hebrews 6:4-6**.
 - What do these passages say about turning away from God after knowing the truth?
 - What are the dangers of falling back into old sinful habits?
 - Why is it so serious to turn away from the truth after having experienced God’s grace?
 - How can you guard yourself and others against spiritual complacency?
 - Who can you invite to church this coming weekend. Pray and make a plan to invite that person?
